## CUTTING GUIDE PROJECTS

### Paper Globes



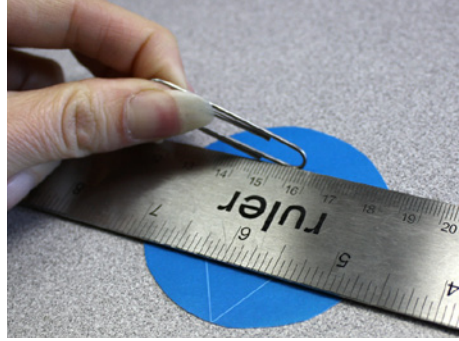
#### MATERIALS NEEDED:

- X-ACTO® Designer Series Scissors
- X-ACTO® Designer Series Metal Ruler
- Twenty card circles printed from the template (you can design your art digitally or use as templates to cut scrapbook paper)

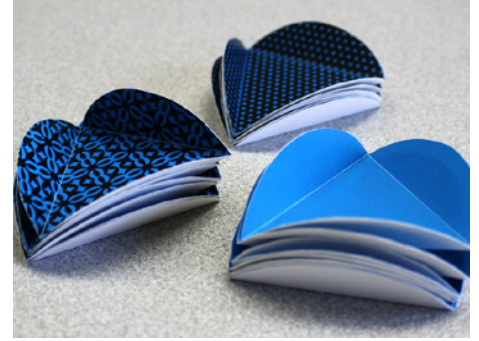

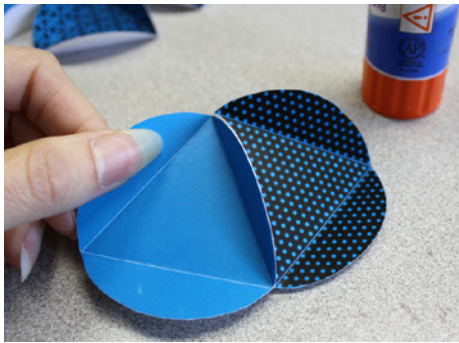
**STEP 1**  
Print and cut out the templates with an X-ACTO knife or scissors. You'll need 20 circles to make a globe.



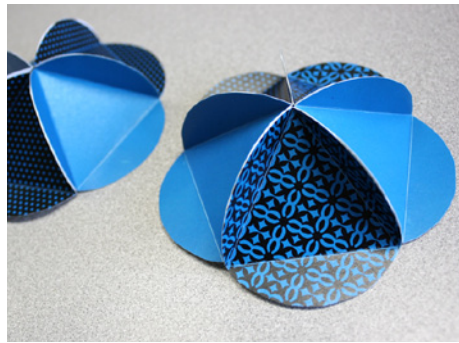
**STEP 2**  
Score the fold lines with the rounded edge of a paper clip.



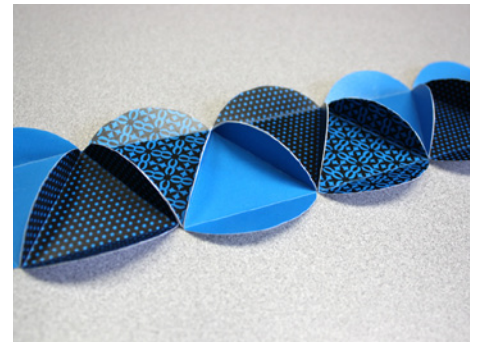
**STEP 3**  
Fold the edges of the paper as shown.



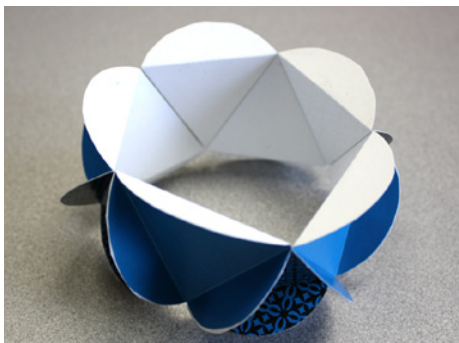
**STEP 4**  
Glue two of the folded edges of the globe together.



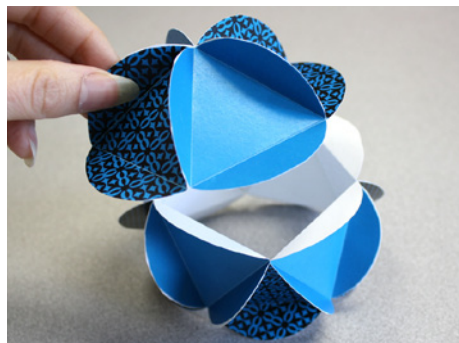
**STEP 5**  
Five circles glued together will form the top of the globe. Create a second form for the base of the globe.



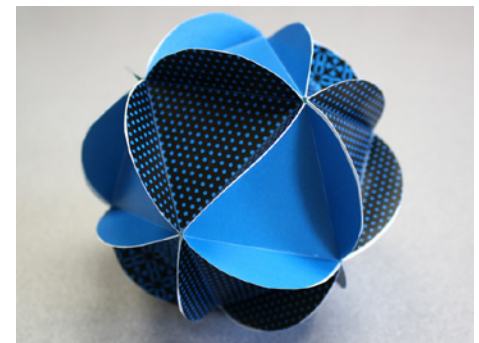
**STEP 6**  
Glue the remaining ten triangles together for the center of the globe. Glue together alternately, so the tip of a triangle is facing the top on one and the bottom of the next triangle.



**STEP 7**  
Join the first and last triangle together to form the center of the globe.



**STEP 8**  
Glue the top and bottom to the center to complete your finished globe. Attach a string to create an ornament or decorate with embellishments.



**STEP 9**  
**Tip:** If you don't get both edges of the globe to line up when glued together, use X-ACTO Designer Series Precision Tip Scissors to trim any excess white areas showing.
